**Description**

running Reposman on Windows fails with a "no such method uid on nilClass" error (perhaps I am paraphrasing, sorry). It appears to be treating the Windows system as if it were a \*nix system. This, in turn appears to be because it is comparing RUBY\_PLATFORM to mswin, and my RUBY\_PLATFORM is

irb(main):026:0> RUBY_PLATFORM  
=> "i386-mingw32"
```

I am running the [rubyinstaller](#) for windows.

As a workaround, I intend to replace mswin with the above string in the reposman.rb file, but a long-term solution should probably leverage the solution in [#1804](#).
