<p>When I break a project into versions, there's only so many (development) tasks that need to be accomplished in order to logically build a piece of software. I don't create custom tasks for 'Research' or 'Testing', but these are technically efforts that need to be tracked.</p> <p>Since they're not always specifically bound to an issue, it would be extremely useful if we could just log time against a version.
