<b>Description</b> <p>On i Wiki Page, i embedded Images uploaded via the Redmine Files section. But sometimes, these Images throw a 500 Server Error (but i see no entries in my Apache log). (I already tried to remove the /download/ part from the Attachment urls when embedding to the wiki, but that does not help).</p> <p>If i attach the Images not to the Files Section, but to a random Wiki Page as Attachment, and refer them, there is no problem at all.</p> <p>I am using the Debian lenny-backport version of Redmine.</p> <p>Database version: sqlite3.6.21 Ruby version: 1.8.7 Rails version: 2.2.3 Redmine version: 0.9.3</p>
