Even though a version is declared as shared by sub-projects, it doesn't show up in an issue's edition form. Setting fixed\_id through the rails console exibhits the right behavior.

It seems as though the code for assignable\_versions in the issue controller needs to walk not only the project but also it's parent's projects in that case, I don't get exactly what needs to be modified here:
