<b>Description</b> <p>The migrate_from_trac task fails if a redmine install has required custom fields on a project. To fix this issue, I added a loop that prompts the user to enter values for all the project custom fields, re-prompting if the input value does not validate for the custom field, and providing the default value as expected.</p> <p>Also, if the project still fails to save for whatever reason, the errors are printed out. Previously, a "method not found on nil::nilClass" was being thrown, which is not as helpful, and was difficult to debug.</p>
