Description <p>The current validation for issues that are linked by preceeded by / followed by issue links is that the start date of the latter cannot be the same as the finish date of the former.</p> <p>For example this is not possible (Issue B follows Issue A)</p> <p>Issue A - 2010/01/01 to 2010/01/10 Issue B - 2010/01/10 to 2010/01/20</p> <p>The following issue must always start on the next day.</p> <p>This seems rather arbitrary and annoying since we have tasks that may finish mid-day and wish to start on the next days in the afternoon.</p> <p>For maximum flexibility I would suggest that the validation allows for following task to start on the same day as the last day of the preceding task.</p>
