<b>Description</b> Right now plugins can only extend the Project menu ("main-menu"). This is kinda awkward for plugins that work across projects (see my <a href="#">Timesheet plugin</a> for an example).  What needs to be done to be able to extend the "top-menu"? Can we just build the "top-menu" using Redmine::MenuManager and hook into it with the Redmine::Plugin.menu method?

```
Redmine::MenuManager.map :top_menu do |menu|
  menu.push ...
end
```

Two other menus can be extended as well:

- account\_menu: the one in the upper-right corner (with login/logout links)
- application\_menu: same place as the project menu but rendered when outside of a project (this menu is empty by default)
