<b>Description</b> <p>themes.rb makes an assumption that the themes css files will be located in the <i>public</i> folder which is at the same level as the <i>app</i> folder. However, in a JRuby on Rails war structure, the public files are actually located in the root of the WAR, whereas most of the other rails app components are under WEB_INF.</p> <p>A workaround is to copy the themes folder into WEB_INF\public which allows the theme discovery to work.</p>
