In RepositoriesController#entry(), String#is\_binary\_data? is used to determine the file is binary or not. But String#is\_binary\_data? return true even if the file is utf-8 text.

I wrote a patch to fix this problem.

I confirmed <u>source:trunk/config/locales/ja.yml</u> is as binary. <u>repositories\_controller.patch</u> is only for UTF-8.

Redmine supports multi encoding.

For example, ISO-8859-1, Japanese Shift\_JIS, EUC-JP...

Iconv passes converting from ISO-8859-1 to UTF-8 with no error.

I will fix #6256 in another way.
