<b>Description</b> I have many projects that start with the same set of parent & children tasks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Do This Group Of Things<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ Setup A</li><li>◦ Configure A</li><li>◦ Test A</li></ul></li><li>• DO That Group Of Things<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ Setup B</li><li>◦ Load B</li><li>◦ Compile X</li><li>◦ Test B with X</li></ul></li></ul> <p>Often I will select the parent task (Do this Group Of Things) and all of its children and copy it to a new project.</p> <p>When the tasks appear in the new project the parent/child relationship is gone. All of the tasks are there but there is no subtask assigned to the parent. I have to manually go in and edit each child and attach it to the proper task ID # as the parent.</p>
