<p>Using version 0.5.0 we had no problems creating link in the wiki with the "-" char in the middle and surrounded by spaces, like "<a href="#">ABC - XXY</a>". This would create a link to a page ABC_-_XXY.</p> <p>With version 0.6.3, the "-" is changed by redcloth into – (longer dash), and then all the links to these pages are gone.</p> <p>As a quick hack, i fixed this by editing lib/redcloth.rb, line 412, and commented that line:</p> <pre># [ /\s-\s/, ' ' &amp;#8211; ' ], # en dash</pre> <p>Perhaps this is an issue with redcloth, but it affects redmine.</p>
