I have similar requirement but i have a "easier" and mabye more lean to actual design proposal to do that.

If you would have a multiselect list for projects mapped to user/groups in Admin>user config dialog, you can give same role/rights for same user/group in several projects. Instead of click thousands of times the same role>user/group selection for diefferent projects over and over again, you could do it in one step.

This would "only" need to offer a multiselect and do a loop in backend with the same logic but for a list of projects inseatd only one.
