Description When I came to change the maximum attachment size, I was confused about the 'KB' prefix used, since 'KB' is not a standard prefix for anything. After doing some quick calculations I actually found out that this field is kilobytes, which is the SI decimal prefix 'kB'. It would be good if this could be changed from 'KB' to 'kB' to stop confusion, and so we actually know what this fields value is representing.
