<b>Description</b> In our environment, applications use port forwarding to avoid using root to start up web services. Port 80 and 443 are forwarded to higher port numbers. This setup does not work with the rdm-mailhandler because it assumes the port number. I created a patch to fix this. The attached patch adds a port option to the rdm-mailhandler.
