If I go in and copy or move an issue there is no indication that I am the person who did the action. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Activity - says the person who created the original issue did the move/copy.</li><li>• There is no note on the issue stating I copied or moved it from issue #</li><li>• The author is still the original person.</li></ul> I can see the author staying the same but the Activity must state that who actually made the change and I would like to see a note automatically added that it was moved or copied. <p>This is a major issue when trying to track down who did what and why.</p>
