If have written a script that is executed with the ruby on rails runner. This script requires all repositories (which can be hg, svn or git in my setup). When a iterate over all repositories it gives an exception on the first git repository. This occurs because respond to without attributes? is not defined on git instances. This only occurs in the runner, not in the a plugin.

I can work around this by wrapping lines 1652 to 1660 with

if object.respond_to? :respond_to_without_attributes?

The side-effect of this workaround is that the type of the git repository objects is not *Repository::Git* such as *Repository::Mercurial* but just *Git*.
