Nope, redmine extends I18n to make l also accept strings, see [source/trunk/lib/redmine/i18n.rb#L7](#), so that's not the problem. It also runs fine in the console:

```
>> include Redmine::I18n
=> Object
>> l(:text_diff_truncated)
=> "... This diff was truncated because it exceeds the maximum size that can be displayed."
```
