<b>Description</b> I feel that the "Fixed version" select box that appears for issues after having created a version is nonsensical, especially for a user filling out a new issue.  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Past tense is just wrong (in any language?)</li><li>• The person filling out the issue will likely have no idea what version the problem will be addressed in.</li><li>• I'm guessing that for most software development, the "Fixed version" will not ever be set when the issue is closed.</li></ul>
