<b>Description</b> <p>The file redmine/public/.htaccess must be moved aside for non-fastcgi(? see: <a href="http://www.redmine.org/boards/1/topics/3417">http://www.redmine.org/boards/1/topics/3417</a> ) installs, but the file is installed by default, and not mentioned in either <a href="http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineUpgrade">http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineUpgrade</a> or <a href="http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineInstall">http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineInstall</a> .</p> <p>Either the file needs to be named something like .htaccess_for_fastcgi or the docs need to be updated. Marking as priority high, because this will break people's setups as they upgrade to 1.1.0.</p> <p>I don't have edit rights on the wiki, otherwise I'd have added a note to the docs myself.</p>
