### Description

Spent time entries which logged from commit messages cannot be seen on Spent time report when Redmine is running with SQLite3.

sqlite> select id, spent\_on from time\_entries;
1|2011-01-10
2|2011-01-10 15:44:00
3|2011-01-10

ID 1 and 2 were logged from Web. ID 2 was logged from svn commit message.

Because spent\_on field on the ID 2 record has time part, the record cannot be seen on spent time report ("Overview" > "Details" | "Overview" > "Report").
