Description

I have updated Redmine to Version 1.1.0 yesterday. Until this moment no more mail notifications will be sent to creator or assigned users. Only mails to watchers are sent.

Works:

- Test-Mail works fine
- Mail notifications to watcher work fine

Don't work:

- Mail notifications to creators or assigned users not sent
- Changed notification settings in my account allways fall back to first entry so I don't know which settings are made.

**We are using redmine hourly with 25 Users and need back the mail notifications very urgently!
I'm really appreciated for a fast help!**
