On revision page, you can change the revision id then click on the 'Ok' button to get to the new revision page. If you remove the revision id field content and leave it blank then you'll get a HTTP 500 error. Additional question (UX) : why is the 'Ok' button displayed on the revision page and not on the repository page ? Tested with a SVN repo.
