<b>Description</b> Most of the current keyboard shortcuts don't work for me (OS X with FF 3.6 and FF 4.0). They are instead preëmpted by system-level keybindings. For instance, Ctl-4 switches Exposé to workspace <a href="#">#4</a> .  Solutions might involve using a different modifier key on the Mac, or using plain alphanumerics without a modifier a la gmail and Google Reader.
