#### Description

I find that the LDAP authentication sometimes works and sometimes fails when I use sAMAccountName attribute to verify the account. However, when I use userPrincipalName attribute as the user logon, it works.

By the way, I am using Active Directory on Windows Server 2003

After trial and error, I found out the LDAP authentication actually does not fail. I also found out that "The user is invalid" because there is already user with the same log-on name in Redmine. This prevents creation of account on the fly, hence generate the "the user is invalid".
