Just FYI, this behavior turns out to be a problem with RedCloth, the library used to turn Textile into HTML. RedCloth doesn't seem to be actively developed anymore and has a number of issues, some of which are listed in the comments here: <http://redhanded.hobix.com/inspect/superredclothAsAChild.html>
