Description When a user attempts to set the status_id of an issue, but does not have permission to do so, Redmine's API does not respond with an error. The status is not updated, yet the response still indicates success. I tested this with Admin user on a fresh instance of Redmine, where Admin was not a member of the project. #8625 is related.

I have confirmed the issue.

The user rhill tried to update the status of an issue in a public project which he is not a member. The issue was not updated because he is not a member of the project and no workflow is defined for him. However, the API returned "204 No Content".
