<p>Some plugins that create classes based on ActiveRecord::Base specify their own table names (with `set_table_name`), which overrides the default table name guessing mechanism. But they do not use `table_name_prefix` and `table_name_suffix` in their table names. So when these are set, the classes are unable to find their tables in the database.</p> <p>To reproduce (an example):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Add `config.active_record.table_name_prefix = 'whatever_'` to `config/additional_environment.rb`.2. Create/init database with this set2. Enable OpenID from the administration settings page3.
