As you might have guessed, I've installed Redmine from an Ubuntu PPA (AFAIK, there is only one) so all the related dependencies (ruby, rails, etc) have been set automatically.

I've also checked the issue list (before submitting this issue) and didn't find anything similar.

As for specific error data: I found this issue to be consistent everywhere these links (check all / uncheck all) are available. However, it doesn't generate any stack trace in /var/log/redmine/default/production.log (which is where the stack traces have been generated with other errors). One example of how to reproduce the issue, is to go to Administration -> Roles and Permissions -> New Role and then click on "Check all". Instead of turning on all the permissions, the screen simply scrolls up a little.
