<b>Description</b> I've not been able to find a plugin that adds a tab that has that tab "selected" when that plugin is active.  As found in other plugins:  <pre>menu :project_menu, "Todos", :controller =&gt; 'todo_lists', :action =&gt; 'index'</pre> puts "Todos" into the menu but is not marked as the active section when navigated to.  But what's really wanted by Redmine:  <pre>menu :project_menu, :todo_lists, :controller =&gt; 'todo_lists', :action =&gt; 'index'</pre> puts "Todo lists" into the menu.  This doesn't pose a problem and isn't really a bug, but I was unable to locate a way to pass in a string that may differ from the controller name.

```
menu_item :whatever
```

or for a particular action only:

```
menu_item :specific_item, :only => :some_action
```
