It would really slim down the current workflow for changing parents (write down parent ID, open issue, update issue, click on (more), type in ID, hit Save).</p> <p>I suppose there's definitely a lot that can be helped by drag-and-drop. This is just the thing that would help me most for my own uses.</p>
