I understand why the sub-projects are not directly linked for users and groups but it would be very nice to have the choice to link a project with the parent.

Instead of settings users & groups for each sub-project, you just have to set the parent link for each sub-project or applying this rule within the entire project in one click and "enable" heritage.

Sometimes, from my point of view, huge old projects are only followed by few users with the same roles at each branche.
