<p>With using copying function for projects in Administration screen, custom queries will be duplicated on "Custom queries (n)" checkbox ON.</p> <p>But the copied queries on target project will disappear from side bar for issues list because of its properties in Private (not Public).</p> <p>The copied queries have user_id = 0 in redmine database queries table.</p> <p>I found this in my configuration with Redmine 1.1.3 stable. Apache 2.2.8 + thin (1.2.7 x86-mingw32) with load balancer MySQL 5.0.51a Ruby 1.8.7-p249 Rails 2.3.5</p> <p>But also I tried and found this with BitName Redmine 1.2.1 Windows installer.</p>
